The founding president of both the New Brunswick Multicultural Council and the Atlantic Multicultural Council, Dr. Passaris is the first New Brunswicker to receive an award from the Canadian Council for Multicultural and Intercultural Education.

Among numerous honors and awards, in 2019, the New Brunswick Multicultural Council presented him with its inaugural Legacy Award to recognize and celebrate his long-standing contributions.
